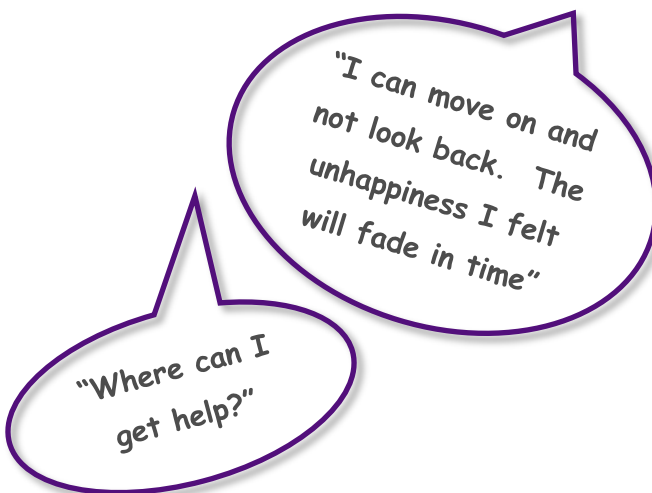

What We Offer

Our service is split into three sections.

These are:

Refuge

When a child or young person enters refuge accommodation with their mother or carer they are allocated a keyworker who acts on their behalf to ensure that their individual support needs are met.

Follow On

When a family moves into their own tenancy follow on services can continue to be offered on a needs led basis.

Outreach

The outreach service is offered to children and young people who are still living in the family home and require support in their own right.

Confidentiality

Our service is fully confidential to the Child or Young Person we are supporting. However, there may be occasions where it is necessary to share things with other agencies to ensure the safety and wellbeing of that child or young person.

Monitoring and Evaluation

We have an independent Monitoring and Evaluation service providing opportunities for all service users to provide feedback about their experiences of Fife Women's Aid services.

We aim to meet the Domestic Abuse Delivery Outcomes as identified by the Scottish Government.

Referrals

Referrals can be made by any Child or Young Person in their own right; by a parent or carer; a teacher or Health Visitor or any other Professional who feels a CYP would benefit from some specialist support.

Who We Are

We are a team of fully qualified and experienced support workers, Senior Worker and Team Leader, who offer a holistic support service to children and young people, aged 0-18 years, who have or are experiencing Domestic Abuse.

All CYP Team Members are registered with the Scottish Social Services Council (SSSC) and have been screened as required by the Protection of Vulnerable Groups Regulations (PVG).

The Team Members bring a wealth of experience and skills to the service, both individually and collectively, and attend regular training to keep up to date with any changes in legislation, policies, procedures and best practice.
